O R D E R

Leave granted.

The appellant is a workmen union and it is aggrieved by the impugned order dated 09.01.2012 passed by the High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi, in L.P.A. No.299 of 2004, whereby while declining reinstatement of workmen, the High Court directed for payment of compensation to each of the employees in addition to what has been paid to them as wages under Section 17B of the Industrial Disputes Act.

By order dated 07.05.2012, rule was issued limited to the quantum of compensation.

Having heard Mr. Ajit K. Sinha, learned senior counsel for the appellant and learned counsel appearing for the respondent, we are of the opinion that in the facts and circumstances of the case, payment of a sum of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand only) to each of the employees shall be just and proper compensation.

We direct accordingly.

In the result, we modify the order of the High Court to the aforesaid extent. This appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
