UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

## O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The parties shall appear before the Supreme Court Mediation Centre for the purpose of exploring possibility of some amicable settlement. The wife is far more willing to put an end to the entire dispute. She does not expect anything from the husband. All that she wants is to put an end to the marriage peacefully and honorably. If that be so, then the petitioner husband should not have any problem. There is no point in wasting their time in different courts of law.

3. With a view to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement, the parties are directed to appear before the Supreme Court Mediation Centre on 18.05.2026 at 11.00 a.m. and reduce the terms of settlement in writing.

4. The parties shall initially attend the mediation proceedings through virtual mode and thereafter if need be or as directed by the learned mediator, they will have to appear physically.

5. The Supreme Court Mediation Centre is requested to give a report to this Court before the next date of hearing.

6. List the matter on 28.05.2026 along with the mediation report.
