**UPON hearing the counsel
the Court made the following
O R D E R**

- 1) Against the order of rejection of regular bail by the High Court and to seek bail, the present special leave petition has been filed. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f.17.02.2024 in connection with FIR No.68/2024 dated 15.02.2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered with Police Station Suryagarha, District Lakhisarai, Bihar.
- 2) Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering that the co-

accused Sohit Raj has been granted bail by the Court *vide* order dated 14.11.2025 in SLP (Crl.) No. 12255 of 2025 and the case of the petitioner is not different from his case; however, on the ground of parity, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail.

3) Accordingly, we direct to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing the suitable bail bonds and sureties and on such other terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the trial Court.

4) Petitioner to abide all the conditions as imposed and shall regularly attend the trial until exempted by the Court. Violation, if any, may give a cause to

take recourse as permissible and the trial Court is at liberty to do the needful.

5) Accordingly, and in view of the foregoing, the special leave petition stands allowed. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
