UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner - husband.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage between the petitioner - husband and the respondent - wife was solemnized on 07.05.2019. It is further submitted that though the respondent - wife herself stays at Chandigarh and she is working as Data Entry Operator at Panchkula, she only with a vindictive approach against the respondent - husband filed the proceedings at a place which is around 80 Kms and is a hilly terrain and the petitioner who is 75% disabled as duly certified and the copy of the disability certificate issued by the Civil Surgeon, Fatehabad, Haryana is placed on record at Annexure P-3 at page No.17. Thus, it is very difficult for the petitioner to attend the proceedings

initiated at the instance of the respondent - wife in a hilly area considering the physical states of the petitioner.

3. Issue notice, returnable within four weeks.

4. In the meantime, there shall be stay of further proceedings in Petition in 125 Cr.P.C./117/2024, titled as "Anju Bala Vs. Pankaj Kumar Mehta", pending before the Additional Principal Judge - I, Family Court, Solan, Himachal Pradesh.
