UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Petitioner with other co-accused persons have been

named in the subject FIR for offences punishable under Sections 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) and Sections 61(1), 318(4), 338, 336(3) and 340(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. Co-accused Manoj Kumar and Anil have already been enlarged on regular bail, whereas, co-accused Paramjeet and Pardeep Kumar have been enlarged on anticipatory bail.

3. Although status report filed by the State speaks about two criminal antecedents, one involving similar offence under Punjab Excise Act, 1914, however, in both the matters the petitioner has already been acquitted, copies whereof have been annexed in IA No. 80263/2026 and one is produced before us during the course of hearing today.

4. Considering the entire facts and situation of the case, we are inclined to make absolute the interim order dated 16.03.2026, allowing the anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail in connection with FIR No. 113 dated 28.09.2024 registered at Police Station Rohadai, District Rewari, under Sections 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) and Sections 61(1), 318(4), 338, 336(3) and 340(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the officer arresting him or the Trial Court as the case may be, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall continue

to co-operate with the trial/ investigation.

6. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

7. Pending applications(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
