O R D E R

The petitioner remained absconded for a period of five years. Section 438 CrPC does not permit entertaining petition of anticipatory bail in case there is an apprehension that the applicant may abscond. Here is a case where he has already been absconding for a period of five years. Petitioner was declared to be proclaimed offender and he had unscrupulously approached the High Court for quashing the said order. Therefore, such an application cannot be entertained.

The special leave petition is dismissed.
