The petitioners allege that they have been occupying the land for quite a long time and theyre may be some problem about their alternative place for residences. Learned Additional Solicitor General points out that the eviction of the residents was initiated for construction of railway platform, terminal and track and for the time being the required land may be cleared by the railways for construction of railway terminal, platform and track. The railways may proceed with the matter in accordance with law as regards the rest of the area. Status quo will continue till railway authorities take appropriate steps in this regard.
