After the matter was argued for some time, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has brought to our notice some of the Government Orders. His submission is that they are not reflected in the judgment, though reference to them was made in the counter. If that is so, the better remedy for the petitioners is to approach the High

Court and seek a review. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty to withdraw the petition with a view to file review petition. Permission is granted. The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn. In the event, the final order is against the petitioners, it would be open to the petitioners to challenge the order in review as well as the order presently challenged. We are told that Respondent No.1 is being given pension on the basis of his services for the period 12th May, 1997 to 31st December, 2007.

As the issue is with respect to the period prior to 12th May, 1997, Respondent No.1 shall continue to be paid the pension in the meanwhile as he is being presently paid.
