O R D E R

Learned counsel for the parties drew our attention to CRLMP No. 17103 of 2012 to submit that the parties have entered into an amicable settlement. Apart from other issues that have been settled by them, the parties have agreed to part company for good by filing a joint petition under Section 13(B) of the Hindu Marriage Act. Learned counsel for the parties submit that this court in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case entertain

joint petition under Section 13(B) and pass a decree for dissolution of marriage. We regret our inability to do so. In our view the proper course for the parties is to approach the competent court and seek appropriate orders from it. Learned counsel for the parties pray for and are given two months' time to file a joint petition and report further developments to this court. This petition shall in the meantime stand adjourned by two months.
