UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

In these batch of cases, in Item No. 101 (W.P.(Civil) No. 381/1997), Shri Gaurav Agarwal has been appointed as *Amicus Curiae*. In other items, it is necessary for making further progress in the hearing of these cases that the Court is informed about the actual status of the cases. This means as to whether it is in any way not ripe for being taken up. This would also further involve finding out whether any further orders need to be passed to make it ripe for hearing. In this regard, we notice that in one of the cases, i.e., Item No. 101.5 (T.C.(C) No. 34/2007), the counsel appearing for the petitioner has passed away.

Shri Gaurav Agarwal, *Amicus Curiae* would volunteer and submit that he will give a little time and collate all the cases, go through the proceedings and make available a comprehensive and combined report so that the Court may

proceed either hearing the matter finally or pass orders so that the matter can be made ripe for hearing. He also submits that he will give a list of the dates and events and also reports which he has made in his capacity as *Amicus Curiae* in the meantime.

Shri Gaurav Agrawal to make available such a report by 02nd September, 2022 with index and pagination.

Learned *Amicus Curiae* will also look into the other items viz., T.C.(C) No. 5/2003, T.C.(C) No. 18/2003, T.C.(C) No. 19/2003, T.C.(C) No. 56/2004, T.C.(C) No. 34/2007, W.P. (C) No. 112/2012 and C.A. No. 7437/2018 (Item Nos. 101.1 to 101.7 in today's List) to give the Court indication of the issues which have been projected and also the names of the parties so that the Court can make progress in final disposal of the matter.
