UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The petitioner is in jail in connection with FIR No.150 of 2022 registered on 27.10.2022 under Sections 302/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at P.S. Manpura, District Solan, Himachal Pradesh.
3. The petitioner was arrested on 28.10.2022 and is in jail ever since then. The charge sheet has been submitted and in the charge sheet, 51 witnesses have been cited, out of which 10 witnesses have been examined.
4. It is a case of circumstantial evidence and there are two witnesses to the recovery of the weapon of crime but those two witnesses have turned hostile.
5. In the facts and circumstances of the case, keeping in mind the long incarceration and the fact that the trial is likely to take sufficient

time in completion, we consider it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the trial Court, provided he cooperates with the trial and appears before the trial Court as and when required.

7. The Special Leave disposed Petition is disposed of accordingly.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
