Heard.

We see no reason to interfere with the impugned order. The special leave petition is dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however submits that the termination of the contract is stigmatic inasmuch as the petitioner may be disqualified from seeking a fresh agency on the basis of a fresh tender notice that may be floated by the respondent-Railways.

We make it clear that the termination of the previous arrangement and the order passed by the High Court shall not prevent the petitioner from competing for any future allotment of agency should any such allotment be

advertised by the Railways provided the petitioner otherwise satisfied the conditions subject to which fresh offers are invited.
