We are satisfied that the petitioner has made out a case for transfer of divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband against the petitioner-wife, which is pending before the Court of Subordinate Judge, Ponneri, Chennai (Tamil Nadu) to the Family Court, Bangalore (Karnataka).
