O R D E R

There is no dispute that petitioner-wife is presently residing in Canada.

2. Having regard to this, we find no justification to transfer matrimonial case being M.P. No. 172 of 2013 titled "Shailesh Dilip Nadkarni Vs. Meghana Shailesh Nadkarni" from the Court of Civil Judge, Senior Division, Pune, Maharashtra to a competent court/Family Court at Bangalore City, Karnataka.

3. Transfer Petition is dismissed.

4. As and when petitioner comes to India and resides permanently here, she is granted liberty to apply for transfer in case by that time the proceedings in matrimonial case being M.P. No. 172 of 2013 remain pending.
