O R D E R

In this petition, the petitioner has prayed for transfer of H.M.A. No. 20 of 2012 filed by the respondent under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 which is pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court at Rohini, Delhi to Family Court at Meerut, Uttar Pradesh.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record, we are of the opinion that the petitioner has been able to make out a case for transfer of the aforesaid case from Delhi to Meerut (Uttar Pradesh).
