Ms. Sakshi Kakkar, learned counsel, who is present in Court on advance notice/caveat, waives service and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Hence, notice need not be served. She seeks time to file her Vakalatnama and counter affidavit(s).

Needful shall be done within two weeks from today.

Rejoinder(s) thereto, if any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner, Mo. Daud Shamsi, shall join and cooperate with the investigation in relation to Case Crime/First Information Report (FIR) No. 489/2025 dated 26.09.2025, registered with Police Station - Kotwali, District - Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh, for offences punishable under Sections 109(1), 109(2), 118(2), 121(1), 189(5), 191(2), 191(3), 195(1), 196(1), 196(2), 223, 310(2), 324(5), 324(6), 61(2) and 62 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Section 7 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1932 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Prevention of Damage to Public

Property Act, 1984, and subject to his doing so, he shall not be arrested till the next hearing.

In addition, the petitioner shall scrupulously abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

We find no good ground and reason to interfere with the impugned judgment passed by the High Court.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
