UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The present Miscellaneous Application on office report for direction. In the instant case, subject to deposit of Rs.1,00,00,000/- (Rupees one crore only) by the accused, he was released on bail. In this regard, the order dated 03.03.2025 and the order dated 06.08.2025 are relevant which are already on record. We need not reiterate the contents of those orders.

2. As requested in the office report by the Registry, we

direct that the interest of the fixed deposit accrued till 31.03.2026 be released in the account of the uncle/guardian who is taking care of the children. The details of the account are already available in paragraph 7 of the order dated 03.03.2025. The amount of the interest till 31.03.2026 be transmitted for the well being, education and health facilities for the children. The uncle is bound to file an affidavit to the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court that the amount as withdrawn has been utilised for the purpose indicated above.

3. With the aforesaid, the instant Miscellaneous Application be treated as disposed of.
