UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Application for modification of the Judgment passed
by this Court in 10.02.2026 in Civil Appeal No.1478 of
2026 has been sought.

2. We have heard learned senior counsel and learned counsel appearing for the applicants and learned counsel for the respondents.

3. In our judgment dated 10.02.2026 in Civil Appeal No.1478 of 2026 at page 3 paragraph 12, line 3 the date "07.09.2019" shall be read as, "18.09.2025".

4. We say so, although the order dated 18.09.2025 was not a subject matter of challenge before this Court. This is because when the order of the High Court is set aside, the order of the trial court made pursuant to the order of the High Court (which we have set aside) pales into insignificance. Further, we have also restored the application filed under Order XXXIX Rule 2A read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 on the file of the trial court.

5. On such restoration and on setting-aside of the order dated 18.09.2025, we find that said application would have to be disposed of from the stage of the order dated 07.09.2019 which was the subject matter of challenge before the High Court in CMJ No.1711 of 2019.

6. Registry to carry out the said correction of the typographical error and reissue a fresh order.

7. Since the suit is of the year 2014, the Trial Court is requested to expedite the adjudication of the suit. It goes without saying that there could be expeditious disposal of the suit only with the cooperation of the parties on both side.

8. Miscellaneous Application is accordingly disposed of.
