Heard Dr. AM Singhvi, learned senior counsel for the
petitioners and Mr. BB Singh, learned counsel for the State of Bihar.
We have perused the order dated 25th August, 2000 in which, as an
interim measure, the petitioners were ordered to be released on bail
on their furnishing bail bonds for the sum of Rs.5,000/- and subject
to the condition that they would fully cooperate in the investigation.
Today it is stated before us that in compliance of the bail order the
petitioners have remained present at Patna on the days their presence
was required by the Investigating Officer.
