O R D E R

1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner - wife.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage between the petitioner - wife and the respondent - husband was solemnized on 26.02.2023 and after the marriage, the petitioner - wife was subjected to harassment and ill-treatment at the instance of the respondent - husband. It is further submitted that the petitioner left her matrimonial home and started residing at her parental home. The father of the petitioner is also having no sufficient means to support the petitioner as he is working as contract labourer and is also suffering from various ailments. The distance between Delhi and Begusarai, Bihar is approximately 1200

Kms as such it is very difficult for the petitioner to attend these proceedings. On these grounds, the petitioner is before this Court.

3. Issue notice, returnable within four weeks.

4. In the meantime, there shall be stay of further proceedings in Divorce Case No.53/2025, titled as "Raj Nandani Vs. Manish Kumar & Ors.", pending before the Family Court, Begusarai, Bihar.
