UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Permission, to file the special leave petition, is granted.
2. Delay condoned.
3. Petitioner alleges, erroneously, that the High Court has given a specific direction for a criminal prosecution to be launched against him.
4. Having read the impugned judgment and order of the High Court, we find that the High Court was alive to the fact that the petitioner was not a party before it and, therefore, only an inquiry was directed to find out as to whether

the petitioner, in any manner, was responsible in facilitating lodging of a false complaint against the first respondent.

5. In such view of the matter, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment and order of the High Court; hence, the special leave petitions are dismissed.

6. If at all any criminal prosecution is launched against the petitioner, he may seek appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

7. Pending interlocutory application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
