Upon hearing the petitioner-in-person, the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The present Writ Petition has been filed for the following relief(s):

a) To issue appropriate writ, order, direction commanding and compelling the respondents to reinstate the petitioner in service to the cost of assistant manager in the 2nd respondent which the petitioner was holding at the time of issuance of Annexure P4.104-105, P5.106-109

b) To issue appropriate writ, direction, order that the petitioner has got a right to continue in service as per Annexure P1.13-21 dated 14th April 2025 order, disregarding Annexure P4.104-105, P5.106-109 dated 23rd June 2025 & 25th June 2025.

c) Whereas the petitioner most

respectfully prayers that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue appropriate writ, order or direction calling for the records, leading to Annexure P4.104-105 P5.106-109. dated 23rd June 2025 & 25th June, 2025 and quash the same.

d) To award compensation of Rs 10Cr to the petitioner from the respondents, for all of that emotional, mental, social, physical & the financial harassment, legal trauma, for all the defame, for never allowing the petitioner to live her life throughout from the date of termination till this movement. Also for never allowing the petitioner to fight for her justice by creating repeated threatening, black mailing and haunting also by trying to influence the judicial officers etc.

e) To issue such other appropriate writ order or direction, which this Hon'ble Court deems fit for the ends of justice to the petitioner."

2. The petitioner, who is present, has been apprised of her right to be represented through a counsel of her choice as also the legal aid counsel (free of charge) subject to her eligibility; however, she has chosen to argue the matter herself.

3. Having considered the submissions advanced by the petitioner-in-person and perused the material available on record, we are not inclined to grant the relief(s) prayed by the petitioner.

4. As such, the Writ Petition is dismissed on merits.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
