**O R D E R**

1. Respondents in Civil Appeal No. 14753 of 2024 seek review of the judgment and order dated 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2024, on the grounds urged in the review petition. The civil appeal of Madanlal Sharma (since deceased) was accepted by this Court and relief granted to him (in his absence to his legal heirs/representatives), upon hearing the parties on all the issues raised.

2. Delay condoned.

3. The review petition has been perused and the grounds considered.

4. Having perused the petition and the grounds urged in support of the prayer for review, we are of the firm considered opinion that absolutely no case for review has been set up. We also hasten to observe that the review petitioners have attempted to re-argue the civil appeal in the

guise of seeking review of the judgment and order dated 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2024. Such attempt is an abuse of the process of law as well as this Court.

5. Consequently, the review petition is dismissed with cost of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) only to be paid to the legal heirs/representatives of the deceased Madanlal Sharma by the State, within 3 (three) months from date.

6. A compliance affidavit shall be filed immediately after payment of cost.

7. We permit the State to recover the cost component from those officers responsible for advising the State to file this misconceived review petition, upon granting them an opportunity of hearing.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
