UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel on both sides. The submissions would reveal the desire of the parties to explore the possibility of a mediated settlement.

2. In such circumstances, the parties are directed to appear before the Coordinator, Supreme Court Mediation Centre on 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 at 11.00 a.m. The Coordinator shall appoint a Mediator to enable the parties to make an effort to settle the matter amicably.

3. Initially, the parties are permitted to appear virtually and thereafter, the parties shall appear as per the directions of the Mediator.

4. All expenses towards travel and lodging of the wife shall be borne by the petitioner-husband.

5. Learned counsel for the appellant undertakes to pay a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) within a period of ten days and remaining amount of Rs.4,75,000/- (Rupees four lakhs seventy five thousand only) approximately during the course of the mediation.

6. List the matter along with Mediation Report on 06.08.2026.
