The learned counsel for the respondents, present on caveat, takes notice.

Heard the learned senior counsel for the parties.

It is stated by the learned senior counsel for the respondents that the processing of technical bids is likely to take at least two weeks and the sanction of the Asian Development Bank shall have to be obtained at every stage, inasmuch as the project is ADB aided project. It is also pointed out by the learned senior counsel that when the impugned order dated 8.7.2005 came to be passed by the Division Bench, detailed judgment of the learned Single Judge was not available before the Division Bench which is now available and the same shall be filed before the Division Bench. Further, the learned senior counsel for the respondents has no objection and rather concedes to the matter as to grant of interim relief being heard and examined afresh by the Division Bench in the light of the detailed judgment of the learned Single Judge. He also submits that

till the matter is heard afresh by the Division Bench, the respondents will not take any step to the prejudice of the petitioners herein.

In view of that stand very fairly taken by the learned senior counsel for the respondents, we are not inclined to entertain these petitions. They be treated as

However, we request the Division Bench of the High Court to take up the matters for hearing expeditiously soon on the judgment of the learned Single Judge being filed before the Division Bench.
