UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioners challenge the judgment and order dated 05-02-2026 in CRM(M) No. 2592/2025 passed by the High Court at Calcutta.
2. Issue notice, returnable on 13.04.2026.
3. Mr. Kunal Mimani, Advocate-on-Record accepts notice on behalf of the State of West Bengal. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondent-State is waived. Let notice be issued to respondent No.2.

4. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted. Let steps for service be taken within one week.

5. In the notice itself, let it be mentioned that respondent is required to file a counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners to serve a copy of the present petition to the learned counsel for the respondent-State within a period of one week.

7. Let counter affidavit be filed within two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.

8. In the event of arrest in connection with F.I.R. No.61/2025 dated 08.03.2025, registered at P.S.Kanska, District-Paschim Bardhaman, West Bengal, the petitioners shall be released on bail by the Investigating/Arresting Officer on such terms and conditions as imposed and found to be just, fair and reasonable.

9. The petitioners shall make themselves available before the Investigating Officer on 20.03.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as they may be required.

10. Needless to add, the petitioners would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses, in any manner, till the completion of the trial.
