O R D E R

1. Mr. Siddharth Sharma, learned counsel submits that he has moved an application on behalf of the informant seeking impleadment. On due consideration, the same stands allowed.

2. Amended memo of parties be filed within a week.

3. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner would submit that the deceased had committed suicide at his own house after three days of the last meeting between the petitioner and the deceased and there is no evidence of any act committed by the petitioner which may amount to abatement of suicide on the date of incident.

4. Issue notice, returnable on 29.04.2026.

5. Counter affidavit be filed by the respondent-State as also by the newly added respondent no.2/ informant before the next date of hearing.

6. In the meanwhile, petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.06/2026 registered with Police Station-Gole Ka Mandir, District-Gwalior, MP subject to the condition that petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation/ trial and shall also not threaten any witness.
