## O R D E R

In our view, while vacating the interim order, the High Court should have briefly assigned reasons for doing so. It's failure to do so has resulted in manifest injustice. Therefore, the matter is remanded to the High Court with the request that the application filed by the contesting respondents for vacating interim order be disposed of by assigning cogent reasons as early as possible but, in any case, before the end of July, 2011.

The special leave petitions are accordingly disposed of.
