in this petition filed against order dated 28.1.2011
passed by the National Consumer Disputes Redressal
Commission (for short, "the National Commission") is
whether the National Commission committed an error by
dismissing the review petition filed by the petitioner
in the backdrop of the liberty given by this Court vide
order dated 16.8.2010 passed in SLP(C)No.22271 of 2010
and that too without assigning any reason.

We have carefully perused the averments
contained in the review petition and the grounds on
which the petitioner had sought review of order dated
2.3.2010 and are prima facie satisfied that the
National Commission committed serious error by
dismissing the review petition albeit without assigning
any reason.
