ORDER

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking transfer of F.I.R. No. 65 of 2003 under Sections 341/323/498A/379/504/34 I.P.C. and 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, P.S. Jalley, District Darbhanga, Bihar, filed by respondent No. 2 pending before the Chief Judicial Magistrate,
