O R D E R

9. Mr. Shrirang Verma, learned standing counsel for the State of Maharashtra, shall apprise Respondent No.1 of the pendency of the present petition, passing of the present order, and his right to appoint counsel of his choice.

10. The Registry to communicate this order to all concerned forthwith.

11. The effect and operation of the impugned judgment/order dated 08.12.2025 shall remain stayed.
