UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Arising out of an interim order passed by the High Court in the petitions filed seeking quashment by the petitioner, the

present special leave petitions have been filed. In nutshell, before the High Court, two interim reliefs were sought (i) the Stay of investigation; and (ii) in furtherance to the order of Non-bailable Warrant, interim protection may be granted.

2. In our view, *prima facie*, stay of investigation in the facts cannot be allowed. So far as the stay of non-bailable warrant, we have perused the reasoning as given by the High Court in particular in paragraphs 32 and 33 of the impugned order. Looking to the same, even after filing of undertaking, when the petitioner has not cooperated with the investigation, at this stage, we are not inclined to interfere in the order impugned.

3. It is suffice to observe that the present order would not adversely impact the merit of Section 482 petition which is pending for final adjudication and coming up for hearing on 27.4.2026. However, these observations are only for the purpose of adjudicating the issues relating to the interim order.

4. With the aforesaid observations, the present special leave petitions stand dismissed. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
