On the facts and circumstances of this case, we think that this is a fit case in which parties should settle their dispute amicably. With the above object, we direct the appellant to pay to the respondent a sum of Rs.2 lacs towards past and future salary in addition to the retirement benefit to which respondent-workman is entitled to. We are of the opinion that this would meet the ends of justice. Therefore, in substitution of the orders of the courts below, we direct the payment of above said amount and benefit by the appellant to the respondent and on receipt

nt mentioned herein above shall be made on or before 15th February, 2005.
