Leave granted.

The appellant seeks regular bail in connection with FIR No.295/2023 dated 17.06.2023, registered at Police Station Ghatampur, District-Kanpur Dehat, Uttar Pradesh for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 302, 342, 328 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

The case of the prosecution is that the appellant, along with four other accused persons, attacked the deceased, leading to his death. It is not clear as to the weapon alleged to have been used by the accused persons.

Admittedly, the appellant has been under incarceration for almost 3 years and only 1 out of 53 prosecution witnesses have been examined so far.

In such view of the matter, we are inclined to grant bail to the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and the appellant is granted bail on terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court.

Needless to state, the appellant shall continue to cooperate with the trial.

The appeal stands allowed, accordingly.
