UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The petitioners have sought certain directions with respect to an unfortunate incident that took place on 04.03.2026, resulting in the untimely death of 27-year-old young individual, besides multiple injuries to other persons.
2. We find that some of the directions sought are essentially administrative issues *re:* safety and security of the victims. In our considered opinion, these and other aspects of the instant petition can be well examined by the Delhi Police. Accordingly, we grant liberty to the petitioners to submit a comprehensive representation to the Commissioner of Police, Delhi. There is no

gainsaying that the police authorities will evaluate the threat perception and will take the remedial measures as may be required. If the petitioners' grievances are still not effectively addressed, liberty is granted to them to approach the Delhi High Court.

3. With liberty aforementioned, the Writ Petition is disposed of.

4. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
