



Six Lakhs from the petitioner in full and final settlement of the amount awarded by the Arbitrator as modified by the civil court. In pursuance of the said settlement, the learned counsel for the petitioner has delivered to the learned counsel for respondent four cheques dated 1.8.2011 drawn on State Bank of India, Overseas Branch, Chennai aggregating to ` 36,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Six Lakhs). Learned counsel for the respondent accepts the said cheques (subject to realisation).

In view of the above, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of as the parties have settled the matter (subject to realisation of the cheques). If any of the cheque are not realised, it will be open to the respondent to seek re-opening of the matter in which event the respondent will no longer be bound by the settlement.
