O R D E R

P Permission to file special leave petition in SL  
(C)...CC.No.3477/2007 is granted.

Having heard learned counsel we are of the view  
that the impugned policy affects large number of persons in  
the State. The matter involves important question of public  
importance. In the circumstances we request the High  
court to take up the matter, if possible, in the week

commencing from 9th April, 2007.

as the respondents are concerned, the same will be done immediately. However, since the impugned orders are interim orders at this stage we do not wish to interfere. However it is made clear that rights created, if any, during the interregnum will be subject to the result of the writ petition. Observations made in the impugned order at the interim stage shall be treated as tentative and they shall not come in the way of either parties herein at the final hearing of the writ petition.

If possible, we would request the Hon'ble the Chief Justice of Kerala High Court to place the matters before the Division Bench as in our view the matter involves question of public importance.

The special leave petitions are disposed of accordingly.
