O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. We have heard learned senior counsel for the petitioner.
3. We dispose of this Special Leave Petition firstly, by setting aside the direction to pay the costs of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only). Secondly, we also permit the petitioner herein to seek a review of the impugned order since the appeal is pending before

the High Court and further the suit is also pending adjudication.

4. It is needless to observe that if an application seeking review of the impugned order is filed by the petitioner herein, the same shall be considered having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the subsequent events, the status and position of the petitioner herein vis-a-vis the suit property in accordance with law.
5. In the event, the petitioner is unsuccessful before the High Court, then liberty is reserved to the petitioner herein to approach this Court.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
