O R D E R

1. Application seeking permission to file the Special Leave Petition is granted.
2. Exemption Application is allowed.
3. This is a petition at the instance of the de facto complainant seeking cancellation of bail of Respondent No.2 in connection with Case Crime No.95 of 2025 registered with Kotwali Police Station, Rampur, U.P. for the offence punishable under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 336(3), 338, 340(2) and 61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 respectively.
4. We take notice of the fact that there are 11 persons named in the FIR as accused including the Respondent No.2 before us.

5. We are informed that other co-accused are still in custody.

6. The High Court thought fit to release the Respondent No.2 - herein on bail.

7. Having regard to the fact that Respondent No. 2 is a lady, we are not inclined to interfere with the discretion exercised by the High Court.

8. In the result, this petition fails and is hereby dismissed.
