O R D E R

1. The petitioner, a lady accused, has been denied regular bail by the High Court in connection with Case Crime Number 484 of 2024 registered with Badwara Police Station, District Katni, Madhya Pradesh for the offence punishable under Sections 8 and 20 respectively of the NDPS Act.
2. The contraband involved in the present matter is recovery of 65.641 kgms of Ganja.
3. There are two other co-accused also from whose possession some part of the contraband was recovered.
4. The learned counsel would submit that the petitioner being a lady and having no criminal antecedents be released on bail as she

is in judicial custody since 29-9-2024.

5. We heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the State of Madhya Pradesh.

6. Having regard to the fact that the trial is in progress and 7 witnesses have already been examined, we are not persuaded to exercise our discretion in favor of the petitioner.

7. The learned counsel appearing for the State would submit that seven more witnesses are left to be examined.

8. Let the trial proceed expeditiously.

9. The trial court shall see to it that the same is disposed of within 3 months from today.

10. With the result, this petition stands disposed of
