



**the Court made the following  
O R D E R**

1) Against the order of rejection of regular bail by the High Court and to seek bail, the present special leave petition has been filed. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f.27.04.2023 in connection with FIR No.132/2023 dated 25.04.2023 for the offences punishable under Sections 302 and 460 IPC<sup>1</sup>(Sections 147, 148 and 396 IPC added in chargesheet), registered with Police Station Chandbazi, Jaipur Rural.

2) After hearing learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case in which the period of

custody already undergone is three years, the allegations against the accused-petitioner is standing outside the place of murder and that the witnesses have not supported the case of the prosecution in the trial; considering all the aspects, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail.

3) Accordingly, we direct to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing the suitable bail bonds and sureties and on such other terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the trial Court.

4) Petitioner to abide all the conditions as imposed and shall

regularly attend the trial until exempted by the Court. Violation, if any, may give a cause to take recourse as permissible and the trial Court is at liberty to do the needful.

5) Accordingly, and in view of the foregoing, the special leave petition stands allowed. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
