Heard Mr. U.R.Lalit appearing for the petitioner and learned ASG for the CBI. The case has already been dragged on for more than 7 years, and yet out of 250 witnesses cited only 50 witnesses have been examined. It is not known how long the trial would take. Ultimately, all other accused persons have been released on bail. In these circumstances, we direct that the petitioner Mohammedumar @ Fighter Majidahmed Pathan be released on bail to the satisfaction of the learned Designated Judge, Ahmedabad on the condition that the petitioner shall surrender his passport if he possesses and shall appear at the Police Station, Shahpur on 10th of every calendar month. The petitioner shall not try to tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner. The petitioner also shall not leave the municipal limits without appropriate permission from the learned Designated Judge.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
