O R D E R

1. Exemption Application is allowed.
2. The petitioner has been denied regular bail by the High Court in connection with Crime No. 139 of 2025 registered with Baikunthpur Police Station, District Rewa, Madhya Pradesh for the offence punishable under Sections 103(1) and 3(5) respectively of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and Sections 25 and 27 respectively of the Arms Act.
3. We heard Ms. Alpana Sharma, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Rudraditya Kar, the learned counsel

appearing for the State.

4. We take notice of the fact that the trial is in progress. Till this date, four witnesses have been examined. The prosecution intends to examine as many as 13 witnesses. We also take notice of the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody past more than one year. We are not persuaded at this point of time to exercise our discretion insofar as the plea for bail is concerned.

5. Let the trial proceed expeditiously.

6. The Trial Court shall endeavor to see that the trial is completed within a period of six months from today.

7. With the aforesaid, this petition stands disposed of.

8. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
