No ground. The Special Leave Petitions are dismissed.

As the order of the Joint Commissioner dated 8.1.2010 has been set aside by the High Court only on the ground that it is opposed to principles of natural justice and on the ground that the Joint commissioner had no jurisdiction to reduce the number of trustees, it is always

open to the Joint Commissioner to pass a fresh order in accordance with law.
