O R D E R

1. Exemption application is allowed.
2. Mr. Anil Lamdharia, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner (borrower), submitted that the total amount due and

payable to the bank as on date with interest is around Rs.41,00,000/- (Rs.Forty One lakh only).

3. We direct the petitioner to deposit 50% of the amount, i.e., Rs.20,00,000/-(Rs.Twenty lakh only) with the Registry of this Court within a period of 10 days from today. If the amount of Rs.20,00,000/-(Rs.Twenty lakh only) is deposited, Registry shall issue notice only to the respondent no.1, i.e., the bank, and invest the said amount in an interest bearing Fixed Deposit Receipt initially for a period of three months in any Nationalised Bank which fetches maximum rate of interest with auto-renewal basis.
