O R D E R

1. Vide Order dated 02.12.2022, the special leave petition of Prem Chandra Sharma against the order of the High Court rejecting his bail prayer was dismissed with a direction to the Trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of six months. It appears that despite seeking extension of time to conclude the trial, the trial has not yet been concluded and, therefore, vide letter dated 08.12.2025, a request of the Trial Judge to extend the period of conclusion of trial has been forwarded by the Registrar General of the

Allahabad High Court.

2. Having regard to the statement made in the letter of the Trial Judge, we deem it appropriate to extend the period for conclusion of trial by observing that all efforts shall be made to conclude the trial expeditiously. We also leave it open for the petitioner - Prem Chandra Sharma to seek for bail pending trial by moving appropriate application before the High Court.

3. However, it is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion whether bail should be granted or not.

4. Miscellaneous application is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
