**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the
following
O R D E R**

1. Against an order rejecting the regular bail by the High Court and to seek bail, the present special leave petition has been filed. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f. 16.06.2025 in connection with FIR No.163 dated 03.06.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 109(1), 61 and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Section 111(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita has been added later) and Section 25(1B) of the Arms Act registered with Police Station Sadar Safidon, District Jind, Haryana.

2. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, considering the role as

assigned to the petitioner and looking to the period of custody which is more than eleven months, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail.

3. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing the suitable bail bonds and sureties and on such other terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the trial Court.

4. Petitioner to abide all the conditions as imposed and shall regularly attend the trial until exempted by the Court. Violation, if any, may give a cause to take recourse as permissible and the trial Court is at liberty to do the needful.

5. Accordingly and in view of the foregoing, the special leave petition stands allowed.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
