UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Applications for exemption from filing Certified Copy of the Impugned judgment and official translation are allowed.
2. Issue notice.
3. Ms. Manjula Gupta, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of Respondent No.1 and submits (i) that the respondent is ready

to deposit the amount, as directed by the High Court, in the bank account of the wife and (ii) the respondent is also ready for mediation since number of litigations have been filed by the parties. The details of the bank account shall be provided by the petitioner wife to the respondent

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is having no objection if the matter is referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre. By the consent of both the parties, the matter is referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre. Parties to appear before the Mediation Centre on 14.04.2026 at 2.30 PM.

5. On the first date i.e. on 14.04.2026, the mediation may take place by virtual mode. Thereafter, the parties are ready to appear personally as per the instructions by the Mediator.

6. For personal appearance of the petitioner, the respondent-husband shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000 per visit, towards to and fro expenses, through RTGS in the bank account of the petitioner-wife, one week before the date fixed by mediator for participation in the mediation process. The petitioner may make available all the details of her account for transmitting the money.

7. After consultation, the report be made available as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of two

months from the date of appearance.

8. Re-list the matter after the mediation report is received.
