Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through this transfer petition filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we deem it fit and proper to transfer the maintenance Petition No.A-609 of 2011 titled "Shri Suraj Satyanarayan Sharma versus Smt.
