Heard.

We do not see any reason to interfere with the impugned order.
The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed. The petitioner
shall however be free to apply to the jurisdictional court for grant
of regular bail upon surrender within a period of three weeks from
today. In case such an application is filed, the court concerned
shall examine and dispose of the same within one week from the date
the application is filed. For a period of four weeks, the petitioner
shall remain protected against arrest. We make it clear that while
disposing of the application for grant of regular bail, the court
concerned shall remain uninfluenced by the fact that we have granted
interim protection to the petitioner.
